## <u>Thursday March 10th</u> Read Matthew chapter 5

What does it mean to be the light of the world?

Is your light shining right now? How so? Who is seeing it?

Before Jesus showed up, the Jews were following the Law. What is Jesus telling us to follow? Is His message different?

Did Jesus make following easier? harder? the same as it always was?

## <u>Tuesday March 15th</u> Read Matthew chapter 6

Read Matt. 6:1-4. How is this kind of leadership different than how the world says to lead?

Why is this concept of performing for God instead of people so hard to do?

Why is this concept important? Is it even worth it?

## <u>Friday March 18th</u> Read Matthew chapter 10

Read verse 1, how is it that the disciples were able to perform miracles?

What authority has God given you?

Verses 5-23. What do you think about Jesus' "pep talk" before sending out the disciples?

Jesus gives a lot of warnings and alludes to how scary life as a Christian can be. What should we be concerned about or afraid of?

Be honest, is it scary to think about being a Christian leader? Why or why not? How can we combat these fears?

Wednesday March 23rd Read John 10:1-18

What does this passage teach us about the protection of Jesus?

What does this passage teach us about leadership?

#### Read John 13: 1-17

The act of washing feet was something reserved only for servants. Jesus is showing great humility in this passage. What is humility? How do we practice humility in leadership?

Who is the greatest?

#### Mark 10: 35-45 & Luke 9:46-48

What does it take to be great when it comes to serving God?

Why is it hard to follow this example of leadership?

### Tuesday March 29th John 13:31-16:33

These 3 chapters take place very close to the death of Jesus. It's kind of his final teaching time before he goes to the cross. He touches on many different topics, such as the Holy Spirit, the world's hatred, and the true vine.

Which parts were most meaningful to you? Why?

In chapter 16 what gift/person does Jesus tell us is coming? Why does Jesus say it is good that He's leaving? What promises does Jesus make about the Holy Spirit? How does this benefit us when it comes to leadership?

#### John 17: 1-26

This is the final recorded prayer of Jesus before he goes to the cross. What does this prayer teach us about the heart of Jesus?

#### Matthew 26: 36-43

Amazingly, for a moment in time Jesus questioned the will of God. Why does he choose to follow the will of God?
